Kenya Airways resumes Malindi Operations

Nairobi, Friday, 12 April 2019....National Carrier, Kenya Airways is set to resume its services to Malindi as from 10th June 2019 with 4 (four) times weekly flights using a Bombardier Q400 aircraft. This will be in addition those operated by its subsidiary Jambo Jet.

The new flights will support upcoming Rome-Geneva flights from 12th June 2019, creating seamless connections between Italy and Malindi to enhance historic economic and social ties, as well as providing connectivity to other destinations within the KQ network. Through the codeshare partnership with Alitalia, passengers from all over Italy will be able to access the beautiful Kenya coastal town of Malindi through a one-stop service via Nairobi.

Kenya Airways Chief Commercial Officer Ms. Ursula Silling said, "As part of our tactical approach to growth, we seek to link key markets within the KQ network to allow passengers seamless connectivity from all points."

Ms. Ursula said the strengthening of the KQ network route continues to be a key focal point for for Kenya Airways and by resuming the Malindi route, KQ is seeking to also support the tourism industry in the Kenyan coast that has seen a resurgence in the recent days.
